Each shift worked, each challenge faced, and each call answered represents our commitment to serving Boone County with integrity, compassion, and excellence.

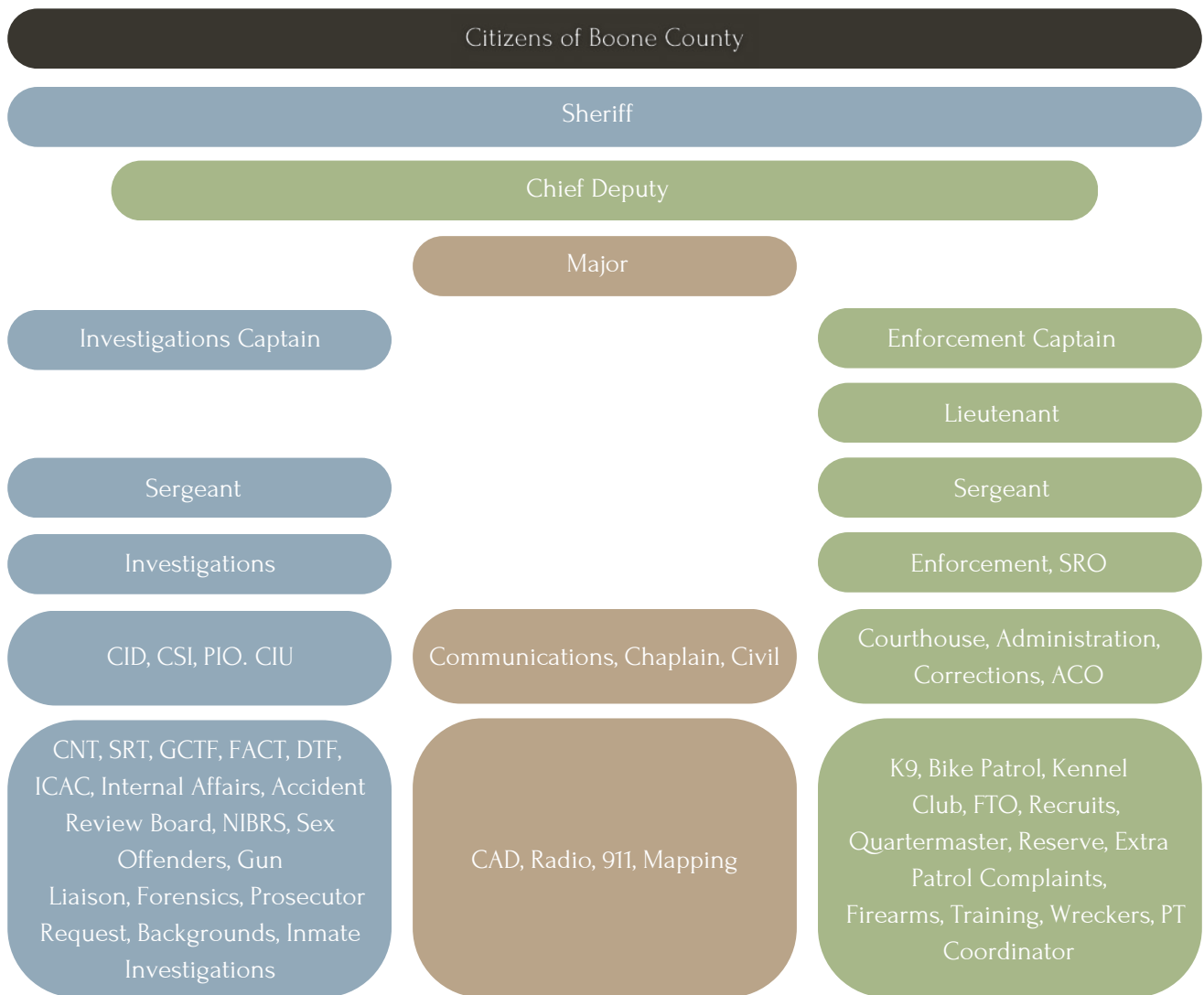

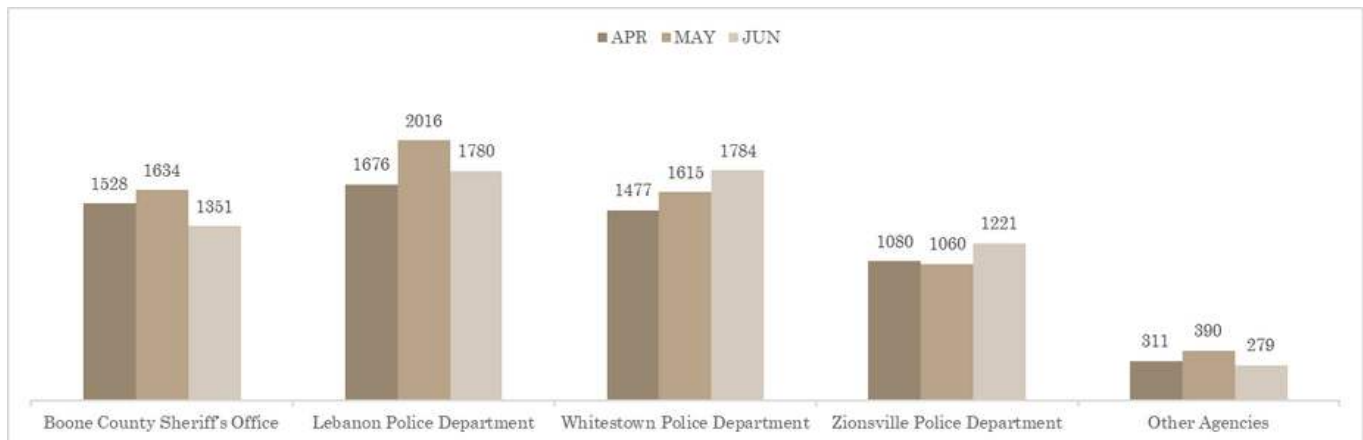

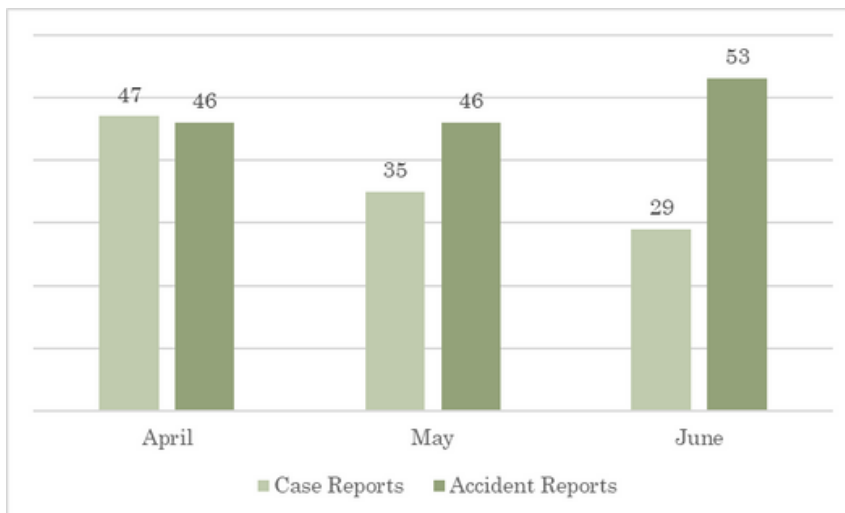

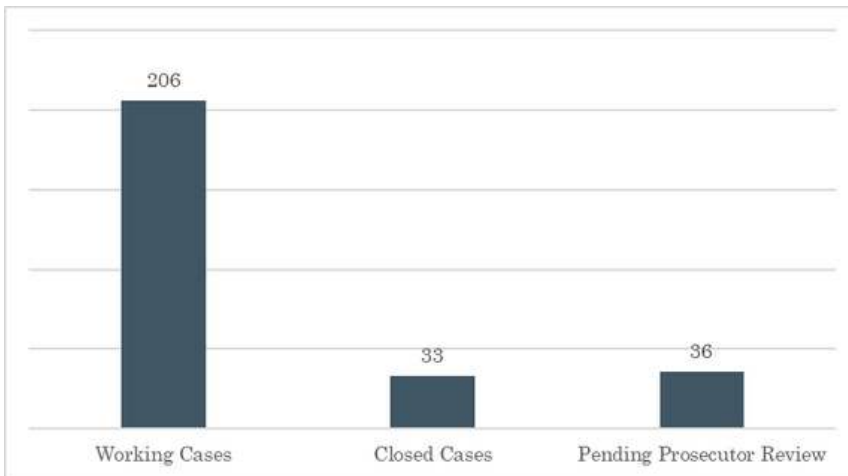

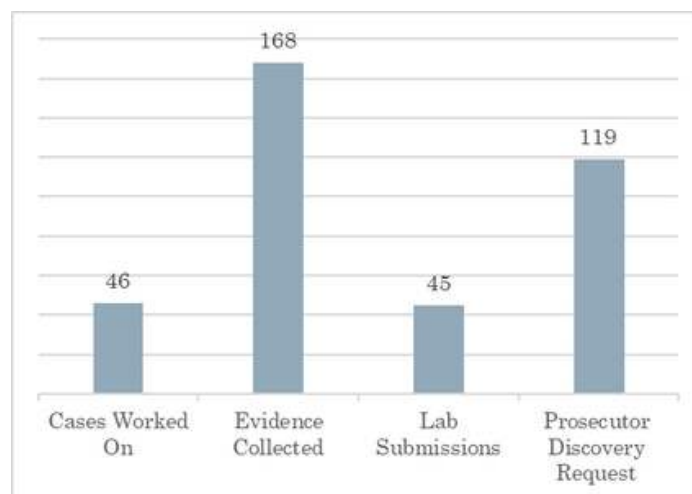
