Three-Day ICAC Operation in Boone County Targets Online Child Predators

Boone County, IN – A coordinated undercover operation led by the Boone County Child Abuse and Sexual Exploitation (CASE) Task Force, in collaboration with the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, has resulted in the arrest of 7 individuals accused of attempting to sexually abuse minors.

This extensive operation brought together dozens of dedicated law enforcement professionals who collectively devoted countless hours to the mission of protecting children online. The operation was supported by an extraordinary collaboration of agencies, including:

The operation focused on identifying and apprehending individuals who used digital platforms to target minors for criminal activity. Undercover officers engaged with suspects online by adopting various identities. These interactions led to the arrest of several individuals who traveled to Boone County intending to engage in sexual activity with minors.

As a result of the operation, 7 arrests were made:

- **Corwin Suits**, 38, of Greenfield, IN – Charged with Child Solicitation, Level 4 Felony; Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony; and Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony.
- **Michael Frazier**, 41, of Louisville, KY – Charged with Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony and Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony.
- **Fredy Leonardo Tomas**, 21, of Indianapolis, IN – Charged with Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 4 Felony; Child Solicitation, Level 4 Felony; Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 5 Felony; and Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony.
- **Izzettin Candan**, 30 – Charged with Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 4 Felony; Child Solicitation, Level 4 Felony; Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 5 Felony; and Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony.
- **Devon Powell**, 18, of Indianapolis, IN – Charged with Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 6 Felony

 - **Harsh Kumar**, 39, of Whitestown, IN – Charged with Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 4 Felony; Child Solicitation, Level 4 Felony; Attempted Sexual Misconduct with a Minor, Level 5 Felony; and Child Solicitation, Level 5 Felony.

All individuals named in this release are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

ABOUT THE BOONE COUNTY CASE TASK FORCE

The Child Abuse and Sexual Exploitation (CASE) Task Force was established in 2023 to support Boone County law enforcement in combating internet-based crimes against children. This multi-agency task force enhances both investigative and prosecutorial efforts, focusing on prevention, investigation, and prosecution of child exploitation offenses. The task force is comprised of personnel from the **Boone County Prosecutor's Office, Boone County Sheriff's Office, Lebanon Police Department, Whitestown Metropolitan Police Department, and Zionsville Police Department**. It works in close collaboration with the **Indiana State Police Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force**. Through coordinated efforts and specialized training, the CASE Task Force ensures a proactive, victim-centered approach to protecting children and holding offenders accountable.
